16.	<u>Resolution No. 60-10</u> – It was the consensus of the Commission to keep this item on the Consent Calendar.
	At this time City Administrator Mitchell recognized Director of Construction Services Wise for his work on the implosion of Tower 1515.
13.	<u>Resolution No. 83-10</u> – Deputy City Administrator Miller responded to Commission questions regarding this item.
14.	<u>Resolution No. 82-10</u> – Commissioner Robinson asked that the spelling of former County Commissioner Green’s first name be corrected to “Addie” and that Ineria E. Hudnell be addressed as Mrs. Ineria E. Hudnell.
