### City-wide Roadway Resurfacing and Concrete Work

Each recipient of this Addendum acknowledges all of the provisions set forth in the Invitation to Bid and agrees to be bound by the terms thereof.

This addendum shall modify, clarify, change or add information and become part of the above referenced Invitation to Bid.

This addendum shall:

1. Provide answers to questions received.

#### **Question 1:**

Are bidders required to bid all items listed on the "Schedule of Bid Items?" Or are we permitted to only bid the items we are interested in self-performing?

**Answer 1:** Yes, bidders are required to bid on all items.

#### **Question 2:**

Will this project be awarded to multiple contractors or only to the lowest responsible bidder?

**Answer 2:** The City reserves the right to award to more than one contractor.

#### **Question 3:**

Are there any estimated quantities that can be made available to the bidders?

**Answer 3:** No.

#### **Question 4:**

Is "Double Course Microsurfacing" actually going to be performed under this contract?

**Answer 4:** Yes.

#### **Question 5:**

1 road project is required as experience on pg 37 of the IFB but "5 years of experience in Florida" is listed as a requirement on pg 110 of the technical specs. We have 30 years of experience with micro surfacing but we recently moved into the Florida market about 3 years ago. We would need the City to clarify this portion of the specs to be certain that we are eligible to bid this project. FYI: We successfully completed several hundred thousand dollars of micro surfacing for the City of West Palm Beach in 2011.

**Answer 5:**

The experience listed on page 37, is the experience required.

**Question 6:**

Is the City considering a multiple award for this project? i.e. If we are the low bidder on the micro surfacing portion of the contract (but not low on the entire bid), could the City elect to award the micro surfacing to APS and the asphalt work to whoever is low on that portion of the contract if the City finds that this would be in their best financial interest?

**Answer 6:**

Yes, the City is considering a multiple award. The City reserves the right to select based on best value to the City.

**Question 7:**

A paving contractor's license is required on pg 4 of the bid docs. I am not sure what this is referring to... The typical requirement for road work is FDOT prequalification. Can we submit proof of our FDOT prequalification to satisfy this specification requirement?

**Answer 7:**

Yes.

**Question 8:**

Is this a multiple-award bid? If so, do bidders have to bid on every bid item, or can they bid just the items they are interested in?

**Answer 8:**

Refer to answers 1, 2 and 6.

**Question 9:**

Also, as was discussed at the prebid, could you please confirm that it is acceptable for the bidders to list "TBD" for the percentages of work to be performed by subcontractors and SBE's?

**Answer:**

Yes. This is to be determined when an actual work order has been issued.

All other information remains the same.
