

Yard Waste (continued)

➤ DONT...

Mix yard waste with any other items

NOTE: DO NOT place yard waste left by Landscape and Lawn Service companies out for the city to pick up. The Landscape Company is responsible for hauling away all debris associated with their work. Multifamily dwellings and Commercial facilities are not entitled to yard waste collection.

For Communities with Automated Garbage Service call 822-2075 for a copy of your guidelines.

Hazardous Waste: Paint, motor oil, pesticides or their containers, batteries, propane tanks, gas tanks, flammable liquids, etc.

DO...

➤ Call the Solid Waste Authority at 697-2700 for advice on disposal of these items.

DONT...

➤ Place at the curb/edge of street for the City to pick-up.

Recycling Materials: paper, newspaper, aluminum cans, plastics, metals. Cardboard boxes.

DO...

➤ Call Waste Management at 547-4000 to obtain/order recycle bins
➤ Call Sanitation to find out your scheduled day(s) for pick-up 822-2075
➤ Place recycle bins at the curb/edge of street after 6 PM the day before normal garbage service and retrieve before the end of the day of collection.

DONT...

➤ Place recycle bins on top of garbage, bulk items or yard waste, or place garbage in bins.

Customer Service: For billing questions or to open an account, please call the Customer Service Department at 822-1300.

Code Enforcement: All violation issues regarding sanitation should be directed to the Sanitation Code Enforcement Officer listed on the citation.

Garbage Routes / Bulk Items

Monday & Thursday

North of Okeechobee Blvd. including Foxhall, and Jonathan Cove

Tuesday & Friday

South of Okeechobee Blvd, including Briar Bay, Hamilton Bay, and Andros Isle.

Wednesday & Saturday

Iron Horse, Ibis, River Walk and Baywinds

Trash (Vegetation) Routes

Monday 23rd-59th Streets, west to North Shore

Tuesday Okeechobee to Southern, Olive west to I-95, Andros Isles, Barcelona to Persian Way, Riverwalk, Hamilton Bay, Briar Bay

Wednesday Belmont to Arlington, east of Olive, Ibis, Iron Horse, Baywinds

Thursday Okeechobee to 23rd Street, Jonathan Cove, The Villages, Foxhall

Friday Southern to Arlington, west of Olive to I-95

Talking Trash



A helpful guide to waste disposal for

Residents

Garbage Service

(household waste consisting of food matter, food packaging and soiled paper)

DO...

- Place garbage at curb/edge of street after 6PM the day before pick-up and retrieve before the end of the day of collection.
- Residential Multi-family facilities (5 or more units) require Commercial Service.
- Bag broken glass and place in container.
- Place residential garbage in sealed plastic bags before placing in standard 35 gallon cans with tight fitting lids.
- Drain all liquids from containers.

***Note: Cans with hinged lids can hinder garbage collection.**

DON'T...

- Place garbage with yard waste (vegetation).
- Place garbage in cardboard boxes..
- Fill garbage can with more than 50 pounds of material.

Bulk Items: Furniture (sofas, chairs, mattresses and box springs) and appliances except for refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners)

DO...➤ Place bulk items at the curb/edge of street, next to regular garbage after 6:00 p.m. the night before pickup.



➤ place major appliances (except for refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners) and furniture curbside with regular garbage

➤ For Illegal dumping call West Palm Beach Police at 822-1600

➤ Roll carpet and tie in sections of not longer than 4 feet and weighing no more than 50 pounds and place with regular garbage

➤ Place bulk items next to garbage

DON'T...

- Place bulk items in cardboard boxes
- Place refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners with bulk items
- Place construction and remodeling materials, including but not limited to lumber, fencing, paneling, drywall, steel, glass, concrete, brick, roofing materials, floor tile/linoleum, plumbing fixtures, pipe and cabinetry out for collection. These items should be remove by a private contractor,permitted hauler (roll-offs) or delivered to the Solid Waste Authority by the customer.
- mix bulk items with yard waste (vegetation)
- Allow bulk item pile to exceed a size of 4 feet x 4 feet x 9 feet, or exceed 50 lbs. Do not break down furniture. Place out in one (1) piece.
- If Bulk is over 5 cu.yds, owner must request a special pick up.

There is a charge for this.

Yard Waste:

(vegetation, tree trimmings, grass clippings, palm fronds, leaves and shrub trimmings.)



DO...

- place yard waste at the curb/edge of the street, after 6 pm the night before pick-up
- Place refrigerators, freezers (with doors removed) and air conditioners next to yard waste.

➤ Place yard waste in front of your property, not on the property line.

➤ Place grass cuttings,small trimmings and leaves in plastic bags.

➤ Limit to 1 pile not larger than 4 feet high x 4 feet wide x 17 feet long(10 cubic yards)

➤ Cut tree limbs and branches into lengths no longer than four feet

➤ Cut tree trunks and stumps into sections no longer than 4 feet and no larger than 12 inches in diameter

➤ Homeowner must clean up debris remaining after pick-up

➤ Call Code Enforcement at 822-2056 for a special pick-up of waste piles larger than the maximum allowed **(there will be a fee).**

***Vacant lots are not entitled to collection service.**

NOTE: In preparation for hurricane season, April and May are "amnesty months" for yard waste collection. Residents may place unlimited amounts of yard waste curbside on their regular collection day.

Normal placement rules still apply. Landscape companies are responsible for removing all debris associated with their work.

DON'T...

➤ Place yard waste within 10 feet of any obstruction such as a wall, fence, tree, guide wire, vehicle, etc.

➤ Place yard waste in cardboard boxes

➤ Place yard waste on top of water or gas meters or electrical lines.
