

Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard Railroad Crossing Rehabilitation:

The South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) will be performing crossing rehabilitation work on Palm Beach Lakes Blvd. in West Palm Beach. This project will require a full closure of the road at the railroad crossing from Friday, February 6, 2026 at 9:00 p.m., through Tuesday, February 10, 2026 at 4:00 a.m. The work may extend through Wednesday, February 11, if delayed by weather or unforeseen circumstances. The work will be performed by SFRTA contractors.

Construction Start Date: February 6, 2026

Anticipated Completion: February 10, 2026


- Rehabilitate existing track

TRAFFIC IMPACTS/DETOURS


Eastbound and westbound Palm Beach Lakes Boulevard, west of North Tamarind Avenue will be closed at the South Florida Rail Corridor (SFRC)

During the closure, workers will rehabilitate the existing tracks, repair rails, and replace the crossing surface to improve the resiliency of the corridor, the safety condition, and the ride quality at the crossing for railway and roadway users.
