Join us in celebrating the waterfront from a new perspective. The City of West Palm Beach and West Palm Beach Community Redevelopment Agency, in partnership with the West Palm Beach Downtown Development Authority, has created a five-month pilot project to reclaim more public space for the community along the Waterfront. From Lake Avenue to Banyan Boulevard, on Flagler Drive, people, bikes, and anyone who enjoys the outdoors now have an additional 63,000 square feet of newly claimed public space. More than a ½ mile of roadway has been repurposed with programmed and community led activations. Flagler Drive is now reduced from four lanes to two lanes (keeping both northbound and southbound traffic flow) for the duration of the project. Flagler Shore continues the effort to make the West Palm Beach Waterfront a vibrant public space for everyone.
